**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Rescinding Resolution 06-2000-163 and Authorizing District I Council Members to review, evaluate, and recommend alterations to existing policy for Tribal departments, programs and enterprises serving the Cibecue community)**

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution 06-2000-163, the Tribal Council authorized District I Council Members at that time to review and take corrective actions concerning problems with administration at the Cibecue Community Complex, Cibecue Cottonwood Gym and Cibecue Community Building; and

**WHEREAS**, District I Council Member Evangeline Gatewood has now assumed the Council seat formerly held by Jacob Henry and Arnold Beach, Sr. has now assumed the seat formerly held by Ronnie Lupe; and

**WHEREAS**, Council Members Gatewood and Beach have reviewed current concerns about the delivery of services to the Cibecue community and a modification to the authority granted under Resolution 06-2000-163 to authorize the District I Council representatives to review, evaluate, and establish policies for all Tribal services provided in the Cibecue Area, including services provided through the Cibecue Community Complex, Cibecue Cottonwood Gym, Cibecue Community Building and other enterprises of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition, the District I Council representatives seek to provide input and coordinate with existing department directors and administrative managers to improve services and better coordinate the existing services to meet the needs of Cibecue residents.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache that:

1. Resolution 06-2000-163 is hereby rescinded.
2. District I Council Members Evangeline Gatewood and Arnold Beach, Sr. are hereby authorized to review, evaluate, and recommends alterations to existing policy for Tribal departments, programs and enterprises serving the Cibecue community, including the Cibecue School Board, with the goal of coordinating and tailoring services to better serve residents of Cibecue and ensure that accountability and effective performance standards guide the work being provided through these important Tribal offices and programs.



**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that such authority shall be on an on-going basis until later modified by the Council and is intended to coordinate existing services rather than create new administrative power over such programs with the intent of better serving the needs of the people of Cibecue.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it will evaluate and move on recommended changes from Council Members Gatewood and Beach when notified thereof.

The foregoing resolution was on May 17, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
