**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving use of tribal vehicle by tribal member Jonathan Baylish)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and


WHEREAS, Jonathan Baylish appeared before the Tribal Council this date to request the use of a tribal vehicle through the Child Find Program; and

WHEREAS, said vehicle will be used to transport student crown dancers to the Navajo Nation; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that the use of referenced vehicle for the purpose stated is in the best interest of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Child Find Program vehicle is hereby approved for use by Jonathan Baylish to transport students to and from the Navajo Nation for the purpose of attending and participating in a cultural ceremony.

The foregoing resolution was on May 24, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
