



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Appointing Lincoln Perry as Chief of the White Mountain Apache Tribe Police Department)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Lincoln Perry has served as Acting Chief of the White Mountain Apache Police Department ("WMAPD") pursuant to Resolution No. 11-2005-319 since November, 2005, and with WMAPD for 19 years, culminating with his position as Lieutenant; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Perry has served with distinction and is certified by the Arizona Peace Officers Standards and Training Board, and the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the position should be funded at \$63,000 annually; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Mr. Perry is suitable to act as Chief of the WMAPD, and that such an appointment is in the best interests of the WMAPD and the Tribe.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Lincoln Perry is hereby appointed to the position of Chief of the WMAPD subject to any applicable background checks that may be required.
2. The position of Chief shall be funded at \$63,00 annually, and such salary shall be incorporated into the WMAPD budget.
3. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 24, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (c), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
