**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Transfer of Title to Building in McNary to Consoni Hill)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Southwest Forest Industries had constructed a number of homes in McNary for its workers employed at the sawmill; and

WHEREAS, after a period of time, SFI workers took possession after the sawmill closed; and

WHEREAS, one of the SFI units, located at 213 E. Spruce in McNary, has been abandoned and condemned; and

WHEREAS, Consoni Hill, a member of the Tribe, has this day requested that the Tribe transfer title to the unit located at 213 E. Spruce; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hill has promised to undertake any and all necessary renovations to the property at his expense; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the transfer of legal title to the unit located at 213 E. Spruce to Mr. Hill is in the best interests of the Tribe and the development of the area.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Title to the building located at 213 E. Spruce is hereby transferred to Consoni Hill, subject to clear title.
2. The Realty Office, together with the Legal Department, is hereby directed to determine whether clear and present title exists sufficient to transfer title to the building located at 213 E. Spruce in the community of McNary.
3. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution, subject to review by the Tribe's Legal Department.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (c), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
