**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving assistance for students to attend UNITY conference)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, Bernita Hinton, on behalf of District III youth, requested assistance with air fare for seven youth and three adults to attend the UNITY conference in Buffalo, NY from July 12 through July 18, 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, the group has conducted fund-raising activities but still need assistance with air fare for the group.


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that funding the attendance for the UNITY conference to be in the best interest of the attendees and the Tribe.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. It hereby approves the disbursement of \$2,500.00 from the Tribal Contributions account to assist with a portion of air fare costs for this group to attend the UNITY conference.
2. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
