

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving lumber for Oak Creek Livestock Association)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Otis Pina, a member of the Tribe, this day reported to the Tribal Council on problems faced by the Oak Creek Livestock Association; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Pina reported of road problems and the burning of their barn and requested assistance; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that donated log lumber, available through the Fort Apache Timber Company, would greatly assist in the construction of the Association's barn.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Fort Apache Timber Company is hereby requested to donate one bundle each of 2 x 6 and 1 x 10 hog lumber to the Oak Creek Livestock Association.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 7, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (g), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
