**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Appropriating \$3,875 for Funding Syracuse University Tuition for Franco Nosie, Jr.)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Franco Nosie, Jr. did this day present a request for \$3,875 to fund his tuition at Summer College for High School Students at Syracuse University, as attached and incorporated by this reference; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that funding Mr. Nosie's tuition request is in the best interests of the Tribe, and may be made available through the Tribal Contributions Account or other suitable sources as may be determined by the Controller and the Budget and Finance Committee.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Funding in the amount of \$3,875 to fund the tuition requirements of Franco Nosie, Jr., is hereby approved and shall be submitted to Summer College, pursuant to the invoice as attached and incorporated by this reference.
2. The Controller, together with the Budget and Finance Committee, shall fund this request from the Tribal Contributions Account or other suitable source.
3. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


