**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving burial assistance for the late Roberto Bencomo, spouse of White Mountain Apache tribal member Gladys Bencomo)

WHEREAS, Roberto Bencomo, a resident of the community of McNary, Arizona recently passed away; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bencomo was the husband of Gladys (Kinney) Bencomo, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bencomo had lived with his wife and family on the lands of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for a substantial period of time, and has been an important and beloved member of the community; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Gladys Bencomo has provided a great service to the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by providing executive leadership at the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority from which she retired recently; and


WHEREAS, Vice Chairwoman Margaret Baha-Walker, on behalf of the Kinney family, has requested that burial assistance be approved for the late Roberto Bencomo.


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the assistance provided herein is consistent with the culture and tradition of the White Mountain Apache and in sympathy to Ms. Bencomo.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it approves burial assistance for the late Roberto Bencomo in the amount of \$650 (\$250 cash assistance and \$400 for the beef).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 8, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (d), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
