



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Right of Ways Improvements for Bridge H083 and Bridge H084)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the SAFETY-LU, "Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient, Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users" provides significant money for construction on Indian Reservations; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Region, has been designated as the agency responsible for administration of these funds for tribes; and


WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Regional Office Branch of Roads, has applied for Rights of Way to start improvements on the H083 Bridge on Route 651 on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, pursuant to Right of Way map assigned drawing number FA-651-1, and the H084 Bridge on route 651 pursuant to the Right of Way map assigned drawing number FA-651-2; and


WHEREAS, after careful review and consideration, the Tribal Council finds that the two applications for the H083 and H084 bridges are in the best interests of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. The Transportation Equity Act applications for the H083 and H084 bridges are hereby authorized.
2. The Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby requested to start the improvements on the two subject bridges.
3. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution

The foregoing resolution was on June 8, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (m), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
