**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Rescinding Resolution No. 04-2006-130 and Providing Former Chairman Massey a Vehicle in Recognition of Service)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Budget and Finance Committee this day presented a recommendation regarding the vehicles provided to former members of the Tribal Council under Resolution No. 04-2006-130; and

**WHEREAS**, the Committee found that the Tribe did not have the funds necessary to provide said vehicles, but sufficient funding does exist for the former Chairman, Dallas Massey, Sr.; and

**WHEREAS**, the Committee recommends that all of the vehicles provided under Resolution No. 04-2006-130 be returned to the possession and control of the Tribe immediately, with one vehicle to be assigned to the Personnel Office and the others to be assigned to other programs by the Tribal Council at a later date; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that providing the former Chairman with a vehicle in recognition of his service is consistent with past resolutions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council further finds that vehicles provided to other members of the Council should be, upon completion of their service, be assigned to programs according to need, and that this should be the standard in the future.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. The Budget and Finance Committee's recommendation with regard to Resolution 04-2006-130 is hereby adopted and said Resolution is rescinded.
2. The White Mountain Apache Police Department is hereby directed to seek the return of the vehicles provided to former Vice-Chairman Endfield, District I Council Members Jacob Henry and Ronnie Lupe, District II Council Member Phoebe Nez, District IV Council Member Mariddie Craig back to the possession and control of the Tribe.
3. The lease for the vehicle assigned to former Chairman Dallas Massey, Sr., is hereby to be purchased and title thereto transferred to him in recognition of his service to the Tribe as Chairman of the Tribal Council.

4. The Controller is hereby directed to expend the funds necessary to complete the lease-purchase transaction for the transfer of title for former Chairman Massey's vehicle.
5. One vehicle shall be assigned to the Personnel Office for its use in the provision of its service.
6. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution, subject to review by the Legal Department as may be required to complete the lease-purchase transaction.

The foregoing resolution was on June 13, 2006 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
