

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approval of Authority to Purchase three new Waste Disposal Trucks for the Public Works Department)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that to protect the health and safety of the Reservation communities, the Public Works Department requires three (3) new waste disposal trucks; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department management has obtained cost quotations to purchase three (3) new waste disposal trucks for the amount of \$554,986; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department management has obtained approval from Lehigh Capital Access to finance the purchase of the three (3) waste disposal trucks in the amount of \$554,986 at the rate of 7.2% over seven (7) years.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the purchase of three (3) waste disposal trucks and approves the financing offered by Lehigh Capital Access for the purchase of three (3) waste disposal trucks by the Public Works Department.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 13, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
