



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Expenditure of \$1,300 in Assistance Funds for the Apache Raiders and Transportation to the Native American Day tournament)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Apache Raiders, a junior league baseball team from Cedar Creek, did this day present a request for transportation assistance to participate in a Native American Day tournament in the Diamond Backs Stadium on July 16, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Apache Raiders has raised some funds from contributions; and


WHEREAS, members of the Tribal Council also determined that a contribution of \$100 per player in assistance for attendance, for a total of \$1,300, is appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the Apache Raiders will represent the Tribe at the tournament and such participation is in the best interests of the Tribe.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that

1. Expenditure of \$1,300 from the Contributions Account is hereby approved for the purpose of the Apache Raiders' participation in the Native American Day tournament on July 16, 2006.
2. Two vans shall be provided from an appropriate program with tribal employees as drivers.
3. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
