**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Rescinding Resolution No. 07-2006-230)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Sections 1(k) and (l) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to appropriate tribal funds for tribal purposes and regulates its own procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Vital Records staff have this day presented a request to rescind Resolution No 07-2006-230, because they request an exception to Resolution NO. 11-2005-344, limiting back pay requests to two pay periods; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Resolution No. 07-2006-230 should be rescinded.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 07-2006-230 is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on August 23, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
