



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Authorizing Transfer of Ownership of Trailer to Alvina Cook)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Alvina Cook, a member of the Tribe has requested that the Tribal Council transfer ownership of a home unit, described as a trailer in the Cibecue community, to the Fort Apache Timber Company ("FATCO") home site area; and

WHEREAS, the trailer has been occupied by Ms. Cook; and


WHEREAS, Ms. Cook is requesting ownership of the trailer; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with transferring ownership of the trailer to Alvina Cook, and its placement in the FATCO home site area.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Transfer of ownership of the trailer home to Alvina Cook is hereby authorized.
2. As a condition of this transfer of ownership, Alvina Cook shall be responsible for securing a land assignment or residential lease for the said home in the FATCO home site area, and Tribal members are prohibited from selling said home for a period of three years from the date of this resolution and selling of the home will require approval from the Tribal Council.
3. The Legal Department, Office of Real Estate Services, is hereby directed to prepare transfer of ownership documents which relieves the Tribe of any further responsibility for maintenance and repairs of said home.
4. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for, ZERO against and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
