



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Rescinding Resolution No. 06-2006-211, Authorizing Irrevocable Gift of Vehicles for Members of the Tribal Council, and Directing Fleet Management Study)

- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has considered the vehicular travel demands of their offices as elected officials of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** a recommendation was made by the Budget and Finance Committee as to vehicles that may have been gifted to Tribal Council members completing their term of office, which was adopted by Resolution No. 06-2006-211; and
- WHEREAS,** upon careful review, the Tribal Council disagrees with the recommendation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds an irrevocable gift of vehicles at the conclusion of a Tribal Council member's term of office is reasonable because of the nature of the service
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council further finds that Resolution No. 06-2006-211 should be rescinded; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council further finds that a review of the age and maintenance requirements of all vehicles operated by all the departments needs to be undertaken, as well as a policy and procedure for fleet management.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Resolution No. 06-2006-211 is hereby rescinded.
2. From this day forward, it is hereby authorized that each member of the Tribal Council assuming office shall be provided with a vehicle at a reasonable price to meet the obligations of said office.
3. Upon conclusion of a Tribal Council member's term of office, said member is hereby authorized to receive the vehicle provided at the beginning of their term of office as an irrevocable gift in recognition of said member's service provided to the Tribe during said member's term as an elected official and representative of the Tribe and its members.
4. The Director of Tribal Enterprises, together with the Budget and Finance Committee, is hereby directed to undertake a comprehensive review of the age and maintenance requirements of all vehicles operated by all the departments, and develop an appropriate policy and procedure for fleet management, in writing within 120 days of the date of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
