



Resolution No. 09-2006-310

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Authorizing the Office of the Controller to apply a deduction to amounts paid to independent contractors for debts to the Tribe)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, many tribal members are independent contractors that are paid by the Tribe for their services rendered to the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, many of these tribal member independent contractors also owe debts to the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Controller is now is now requesting that the Tribal Council approve deductions from service payments made to tribal member debtors; and


WHEREAS, the industry standard is to consider 2/3 or 66.7% of all contract work as labor with the remainder considered material expense, so the Office of the Controller recommends that we apply a deduction of up to 25% of the 66.7% paid to the tribal member independent contractor; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interests of the Tribe to apply a deduction of up to 25% of the 66.7% paid to the tribal member independent contractors that owe debts to the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby Directs the Office of the Controller to apply a deduction of up to 25% of the 66.7% paid to the tribal member independent contractors that owe debts to the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
