



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Rescinding Resolution No. 06-2006-211 Appointing Everett Little Whiteman to the Position of Acting Chief and Returning Mr. Whiteman to the Position of Assistant Chief of WMAPD)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 06-2006-211, the Tribal Council did appoint Everett Little Whiteman as Acting Chief of WMAPD; and

WHEREAS, Assistant Chief Whiteman has indicated that he does not want the position of Acting Chief; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety has recommended Raymond Burnette for the position of Acting Chief; and


WHEREAS, Raymond Burnette has served with distinction and is certified by the Arizona Peace Officers Standards and Training Board, and the Federal Law Enforcement Training Academy of the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the recommendation for the appointment of Raymond Burnette to the position as Acting Chief.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Resolution No. 06-2006-211 appointing Everett Little Whiteman to the position of Acting Chief is hereby rescinded.
2. The Executive Director of the Tribe's Division of Public Safety is hereby directed to process the necessary administrative documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 19, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
