**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Authorizing Political Campaign Contribution to Congressman Rick Renzi and the Arizona Republican Party)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chairman of the Tribal Council did this day advise the Tribal Council of a meeting on October 4, 2006, with the President of the United States and of a fund raiser for Congressman Rick Renzi; and

**WHEREAS**, Congressman Renzi seeks a campaign contribution of \$2,000.00 and a similar contribution to the Arizona Republican Party; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribe's Legal Department has advised that such a contribution to Congressman Renzi and the Arizona Republican Party is allowable under state and federal law, as are individual campaign contributions, subject to certain limitations on combined totals; and

**WHEREAS**, Congressman Renzi has been a strong supporter of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the areas of gaming, education, transportation, social services and other areas; and


**WHEREAS**, after careful consideration, the Tribal Council concurs and finds it to be in the best interests of the Tribe that the Tribe make a \$2,000.00 contribution to both Congressman Renzi and the Arizona Republican Party.


**NOW BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Two contributions of \$2,000.00 each are hereby authorized to be made to the Rick Renzi Campaign and the Arizona Republican Party, and such contributions shall be expended from the budget of the Tribe's Legal Department.
2. Any campaign contribution authorized herein shall be made subject to the limitations set forth under State and federal law.
3. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 26, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
