



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Directing Tribal Social Services to Provide Certain Assistance for the Campbell family)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, Merle Campbell, a member of the Tribe, by and through Council Member DeClay, did this day present a request for assistance, as attached and incorporated by this reference, because of an eviction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Campbell family was temporarily placed at the Hon-Dah Resort through October 2, 2006; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribe's Department of Social Services does provide certain services to those in need; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that the Tribe's Department of Social Services should provide what assistance as may be available to the Campbell family, and that whatever charges have been incurred by Hon-Dah Resort should be waived.

**NOW BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. The Tribe's Department of Social Services is hereby directed to provide such assistance as may be available to Mr. Campbell and his family.
2. Hon-Dah Resort is hereby requested to waive whatever charges have been incurred by the Campbell family.

The foregoing resolution was on September 26, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
