



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Housing Improvement Program Selections for Construction)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised by the Housing Improvement Programs (HIP) Coordinator, Albert Standing, Sr., that it is imperative that they authorize the selection of persons for Fiscal Year 2006 Housing Improvement Program homes and the construction of said homes in compliance with the Housing Improvement Programs Grant; and


WHEREAS, it is recommended to the Tribal Council that authorization be granted for construction of five (5) new homes for FY 2006 Housing Improvement Programs contract; and


WHEREAS, the final selections are as follows: Kenzie Newhall, Abeita Cromwell, Donna Manuel, David Massey, and Doris Moody; and

WHEREAS, these applicants meet the requirements to receive assistance under the Housing Improvement Programs.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the selection of the above five (5) names for the Housing Improvement Programs for Fiscal Year 2006 as advised by the HIP Coordinator.

The foregoing resolution was on November 1, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
