**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Authorizing Filming by John Capobianco on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, John Capobianco, a film producer, has this day come before the Tribal Council with a request for a permit to film, "Call Me Running Wolf," a feature film about an American Indian, Vietnam War veteran, suffering from post-traumatic stress syndrome and alcoholism; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Capobianco has submitted "Partnership Proposals," as attached and incorporated by this reference; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that "Partnership Proposal No. 1" of interest, subject to a written agreement, but that a reasonable location fee be included; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that a film permit for the film described herein to be in the best interests of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. A film permit for John Capobianco is hereby authorized.
2. Said permit shall be in the form of a written agreement, include a reasonable location fee, and be subject to the laws and traditions of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
3. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on November 2, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
