



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving an Increase of \$34,896 to the Safety Department Budget for Fiscal Year 2006-2007)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribe's Budget and Finance Committee did this day present an analysis of the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Budget for the Safety Director (Account No. 001-027), as attached and incorporated by this reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the Safety Director requested an increase to Salaries (\$21,798), Payroll Taxes & Benefits (\$6,323) and Vehicle Operation (\$6,975), for a cumulative budget increase of \$34,896; and


**WHEREAS**, former Chairman Massey had provided salary increases to the Director, and authorized an additional hire, without a budget increase; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that the proposed increase to be justifiable and in the best interest of the program and the Tribe.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. A budget increase of \$34,896 is hereby approved to be made to the Safety Director Budget (Account No. 001-027) for Fiscal Year 2006-2007, as attached and incorporated by this reference.
2. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on November 8, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
