WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


(Approving Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp for June 4-6, 2007)


- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council supports carefully designed research and service projects to evaluate infectious disease and behavioral health problems which exist in the population and to develop appropriate interventions which seek to decrease or alleviate these problems; and
- WHEREAS,** Johns Hopkins, in partnership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe, has agreed to assist in efforts to find ways to raise the self-sufficiency of Indian communities to the highest possible level and to promote and celebrate all that is healthy and positive in the lives of our Native Youth; and
- WHEREAS,** Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp, scheduled for June 4 – 6, 2007 in Whiteriver, Arizona, will celebrate the 11th anniversary year of the Camp and the 5th year the White Mountain Apache Tribe has served as host; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that the Tribe, as host of this year's Camp, should provide, as in years' past, the following: lodging at Hon-Dah Resort for visiting athletes and JHU Baltimore coordinators, Hosting of Community Feast, Welcome Address/Farewell Ceremony and All-Star Basketball Game Presentations and approval for a Native Visions Year-Round Youth Recreation League program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Johns Hopkins Center for American Indian Health, in partnership with the NFL Players Association, to serve as the coordinating group for the Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp, June 4 – 6, 2007 in Whiteriver, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the following assistance shall be provided by the Tribe: lodging at Hon-Dah Resort for visiting athletes and JHU Baltimore coordinators, Hosting of Community Feast, Welcome Address/Farewell Ceremony and All-Star Basketball Game Presentations, and approval for a Native Visions Year-Round Youth Recreation League program.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 2007 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a),(b), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
