



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Emergency Assistance Expenditure of \$200 from Tribal Contributions for Jovacka Armstrong)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, a request for emergency assistance in the amount of \$200 was made this day by Jovacka Armstrong, a member of the Tribe, who requires \$200 in funds to move her newly acquired mobile home from Showlow to McNary; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Armstrong represents that if she does not have the home towed off the seller's lot by March 30, 2007, the seller will void the sale and she may lose some of her deposit; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Armstrong further represents that the cost of towing the home amounts to \$200; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that an expenditure of \$200 from the Tribal Contributions Account is appropriate and in the best interest of Jovacka Armstrong; and

WHEREAS, an appropriation for said expenditure is required because the Tribal Contributions Account has not been replenished; and

WHEREAS, given the urgency of Ms. Armstrong's request, the Tribal Council further finds that the an emergency expenditure needs to be considered and made outside of its regularly scheduled meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that: (1) this Resolution may be voted upon by signature of a member of the Tribal Council where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (2) the Tribal Council Secretary should attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (3) no signature would mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (4) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:


1. An appropriation of \$200 is hereby authorized for the purposes described herein, and said amount shall be deposited by the Treasurer into the Tribal Contributions Account and all budgets thereto shall be adjusted accordingly.
2. An emergency assistance expenditure from the Tribal Contributions Account in the amount of \$200 is hereby authorized for Jovacka Armstrong for the purposes described herein.


3. The Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that given the urgency of the request of Ms. Armstrong, this Resolution may be voted upon as follows: (a) by signature of a member of the Tribal Council, including the Chairman of the Tribal Council and the Vice-Chairwoman of the Tribal Council, where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (b) the Tribal Council Secretary shall attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (c) no signature shall mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (d) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature, and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

The foregoing resolution was on March 29, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




