**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Referring Yolanda Joe concerns to Human Resources Director  
and Chief of Government Services)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and


**WHEREAS**, Yolanda Joe, a former part-time employee of KNNB, today reported in executive session to the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe regarding her concerns; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that the matter should be referred to the Tribe's Human Resources Director and Chief of Government Services.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. The matter of Yolanda Joe's concerns is hereby referred to the Human Resources Director and Chief of Government Services for their review.
2. Both the Human Resources Director and Chief of Government Services are hereby directed to report their findings to the Tribal Council within five (5) working days of the date of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 2007 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
