



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving Expenditure of \$4,000 in Financial Assistance for Jaron James)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, Marvene James, a member of the Tribe, did this day present a request to the Tribal Council for financial assistance for her son, Jaron James, to participate in the Elks National Basketball Free-Throw Competition in Springfield, Massachusetts, April 19-22, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, after discussion, the Tribal Council determine it is reasonable to fund the request at the amount of \$4,000, and that Jaron should receive an embroidered Hon-Dah Casino jacket; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that funding the request will allow Jaron to represent the Tribe at the Competition, and that his participation is in the best interest of the Tribe.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. An expenditure of \$4,000 in financial assistance is hereby approved for Marvene James in order for her son Jaron to participate in the Elks National Basketball Free-Throw Competition in Springfield, Massachusetts, April 19-22, 2007.
2. The Controller is hereby directed to make said expenditure from the Tribal Contributions Account.
3. The management of Hon-Dah Casino and Resort is hereby directed to provide Jaron James with an embroidered Hon-Dah Casino jacket.
4. The Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
