



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** members of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are duly elected representatives of the people and their respective districts; and among their many concerns are the health and well-being of its Tribal Members; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council supports carefully designed research projects to evaluate health problems which exist in the population and to develop appropriate interventions which seek to decrease or alleviate these problems; and

**WHEREAS,** Johns Hopkins is requesting permission to present study findings in the following medical journal: Pediatrics Infectious Disease Journal. The manuscript submitted for publication approval is Pneumococcal antibody evaluation in a child with type 14 breakthrough invasive pneumococcal disease following pneumococcal conjugate vaccine. No personal identifiers are indicated or referenced and all information contained in the manuscripts is submitted for the purpose of developing strategies designed to intervene and diminish the problems associated with pneumococcal disease; and

**WHEREAS,** the publication of the manuscript Pneumococcal antibody evaluation in a child with type 14 breakthrough invasive pneumococcal disease following pneumococcal conjugate vaccine, if approved, will be published in the Pediatrics Infectious Disease Journal.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves that the manuscript listed be published as identified.

The foregoing resolution was on March 8, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
