

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

## (Approving Expenditure of \$500.00 Emergency Financial Assistance for family of Augustine Caddo)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Glenda Lee did this day report to the Tribal Council that Augustine Caddo remains in critical care at a hospice in Glendale; and
- WHEREAS, the Caddo family is in need of emergency financial assistance to attend to the needs of Mr. Caddo; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that \$500.00 in emergency financial assistance from the Tribal Contributions Account is appropriate and in the best interest of the family and the Tribe.

## BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- 1. An expenditure of \$500.00 from the Tribal Contributions Account is hereby approved for the purposes of providing emergency financial assistance to Glenda Lee for the Caddo family.
- 2. The Controller is hereby directed to expend \$500.00 from the Tribal Contributions Account for the purposes described herein.
- 3. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 13, 2007 adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (b), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
