



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


**(Approving Ndee bi ni'bida'ilzaahi Project and Appropriating \$24,000 in Funding)**


- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** Judy Dehose, Executive Assistant to District I Council Members Beach and Gatewood, did this day present a proposal for the Ndee bi ni'bida'ilzaahi Project, as attached and incorporated by this reference; and
- WHEREAS,** the project engages Cibecue high school and college students in observing and interpreting ecological change through repeat photography of wetlands in Cibecue; and
- WHEREAS,** the project requires \$24,000 in initial funding, for which a budget has not been developed; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that funds are available in the Tribal Contributions Account, and that these could be reimbursed through either the Land Restoration Fund or Ak-Chin Fund if available and approved; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council further finds that Ndee bi ni'bida'ilzaahi Project as in the best interests of students and the Tribe.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. The Ndee bi ni'bida'ilzaahi Project is hereby approved
2. The Controller is directed to provide \$24,000 in initial funding to the Project for expenditure for the purposes described herein, subject to a budget to be submitted by Ms. Dehose.
3. Ms. Dehose is further directed to submit the Project for consideration for funding by the Land Restoration Fund or the Ak-Chin Fund, and that said funds if approved shall reimburse the Tribal Contributions Account.
4. The Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 13, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
