



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Listing Reservation Route 4 on the IRR Inventory and Granting Gratuitous Right-of-Way to Construct, Maintain and Make Repairs and Improvements)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 03-99-49, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe adopted certain community streets to be listed as priorities on the Indian Rural Road Inventory for the BIA road construction within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Roads Committee, at a duly convened meeting, did approve and did this day recommend to the Tribal Council that two entries onto Reservation Route 4 be listed on the IRR Inventory: (1) West Street South, West 9th Street, & 8th Street and (2) West Street North onto the IRR Inventory; and

WHEREAS, the Committee also approved and recommends granting gratuitous rights-of-way thereto for the purpose of developing Reservation Route 4; and

WHEREAS, after careful review and consideration, the Tribal Council concurs with the Tribal Roads Committee's recommendations as in the best interests of the transportation systems within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby agrees to list as priorities for the IRR Inventory two entries onto Route 4: (1) West South Street, West 9th Street, & 8th Street, and (2) West Street North.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the Bureau of Indian Affairs a gratuitous right-of-way for the purpose of developing FAIR Route 4 to construct, maintain and make repairs and improvements.



Resolution No. 03-2007-078

The foregoing resolution was on March 14, 2007 adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (c), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
