



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Authorizing Purchase of Radio Adapters for Members of the Tribal Council)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, District IV Council Member Reno Johnson, Sr. brought forward a concern regarding public safety communications on police radios; and


WHEREAS, Council Member Johnson recommended that each council member be provided with two-way radios to allow communication with Police, Game & Fish and Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Council Member Johnson, and finds that providing two-way radios would facilitate their duties as members of the Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that an expenditure is hereby authorized for the purchase of two-way radios that will allow communication with Police, Game & Fish and Fire Department by individual members of the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on APRIL 24, 2007 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
