

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Business License for Mervyn Skidmore, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, to Operate a Recycling Business)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has the authority to issue business licenses, pursuant to the White Mountain Apache Business Code, Section 1.1 *et seq.*; and
- WHEREAS, Mervyn Skidmore, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, has this day requested a business license to operate Northside Recycling, an Indian owned recycling business, serving the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that issuance of a business license is in the best interests of Mervyn Skidmore, and the Tribe's overall economic development.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- 1. A business license for Mervyn Skidmore, doing business as Northside Recycling is hereby approved, pursuant to the White Mountain Apache Business Code ("WMABC"), Section 1.1 et seq.
- 2. The Secretary of the Tribal Council and/or the Treasurer is hereby directed to issue said license in accordance with the provisions of the WMABC.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>APRIL 25, 2007</u> adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (b), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
