



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Requesting Hon-Dah Casino and Resort Management to Promote  
Joseph Wilson to the Position of Executive Chef)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, Joseph Wilson, a member of the Tribe, did this day present his concerns about personnel actions at Hon-Dah Casino and Resort; and

**WHEREAS**, according to Mr. Wilson, he was supposed to have been trained for the position of Executive Chef, beginning July, 2006, but did not receive training from management, and instead sought training on his own; and

**WHEREAS**, other employees similarly expressed their concerns, and noted that Mr. Wilson was qualified for the position of Executive Chef; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Wilson requests that he be promoted to the position of Executive Chef, because he has had sufficient training and experience, he is a member of the Tribe, and should not be overlooked; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council concurs with Mr. Wilson, and finds that he has sufficient training and management experience and should be promoted by the management of the Casino for the position of Executive Chef.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the management of Hon-Dah Casino and Resort is hereby directed to promote Joseph Wilson, a member of the Tribe, for the position of Executive Chef.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
