



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving Land Assignment request for Beverly Townsend)**

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** tribal member Beverly Townsend this day requested 2.29 acres of land in McNary for the purpose of building a church; and

**WHEREAS,** the area requested is not a business site; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that the proposed use of the site is in the best interest of the McNary community residents.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. It hereby approves the land request of 2.29 acres in McNary for Beverly Townsend.
2. A lease is hereby granted for the purpose described herein.
3. The Realty Office is hereby directed to negotiate and prepare a lease of the property to Ms. Townsend.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (c), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
