

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Business License for Christian Bookstore and Counseling Center to operate a business within the Old Parsonage building of the Open Bible Lutheran Church, WELS Lutheran Apache Mission)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has the authority to issue business licenses, pursuant to the White Mountain Apache Tribe Business Code, Section 1.1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Open Bible Lutheran Church, WELS Lutheran Apache Mission has this day requested a business license to operate a business to be known as Christian Bookstore and Counseling Center, serving the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Bookstore will be located within the Old Parsonage building of the Open Bible Lutheran Church, within property currently leased by the Mission from the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that issuance of a business license is in the best interests of the Open Bible Lutheran Church, and the Tribe's overall economic development.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- 1. A business license for the Open Bible Lutheran Church, WELS Lutheran Apache Mission, doing business as Christian Bookstore and Counseling Center, is hereby approved, pursuant to the White Mountain Apache Tribe Business Code ("WMABC"), Section 1.1 et seq.
- 2. The Secretary of the Tribal Council and/or the Treasurer is hereby directed to issue said license in accordance with the provisions of the WMABC.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 11, 2007</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
