



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


(Approving payment of services rendered to Arlonzo Banashley Henry)

- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** Arlonzo Banashley Henry has informed the Tribal Council that he has yet to be paid for services rendered at the Cibecue Commercial Center; and
- WHEREAS,** payment is denied him due to Resolution No. 06-2007-256 (Cost Containment Measures); and
- WHEREAS,** members of the Tribal Council agrees that Mr. Henry should be compensated for completed work.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Resolution No. 06-2007-256 is hereby amended for the limited purpose of approving payment to Arlonzo Banashley Henry in the amount of \$782.80 for services rendered.
2. Funds for payment are hereby authorized and these shall be charged to Cibecue Commercial Center accordingly.

The foregoing resolution was on August 1, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a), (b), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
