

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Directing Social Services and/or Hon-Dah Casino to Provide Pine Tree Clan Singers and Dancers Gallup Intertribal Ceremonial on August 9-12, 2007)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, members of the Pine Tree Clan Singers and Dancers did this day request vans to transport up to fifteen of its members to the Gallup Intertribal Ceremonial on August 9-12, 2007; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the Pine Tree Clan Singers and Dancers are cultural ambassadors of the Tribe, and that their participation in the Ceremonial is in the best interests of the Tribe in promoting White Mountain Apache culture and traditions.
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that the Division of Social Services and/or Hon-Dah Casino should provide vans to transport the Pine Tree Clan Singers and Dancers to the Gallup Intertribal Ceremonial.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- 1. The Division of Social Services is hereby directed to provide van transportation for the Pine Tree Clan Singers and Dancers so that they may participate in the Gallup Intertribal Ceremonial on August 9-12, 2007.
- 2. In the alternative, if DSS has no vehicles available, Hon-Dah Casino is hereby requested to provide such transportation service.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 8, 2007</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
