

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving assistance for John F. Kennedy 8th Grade Student Trip)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a0 of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed of John F. Kennedy School's (JFK) conflicts scheduling a basketball tournament at the Memorial Hall for fund raising purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that assistance of \$12,000.00 should be granted, as it is in the best interests of the Tribe and the education of tribal youth.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- 1. Funding of \$12,000.00 is hereby appropriated for the purposes contemplated herein.
- 2. The Treasurer and the Chief Financial Officer are hereby directed to make payment to John F. Kennedy School 8th Grade Class, and adjust all budgets accordingly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on October 10, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
