WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Raymus Albert, Land Office Director, has come before the Tribal Council this date requesting approval of the Land Board meeting minutes for April 24, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after reviewing the Land Board meeting minutes, agrees that the Land Board meeting minutes for April 24, 2008 should be approved.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Land Board meeting minutes for April 24, 2008.

Meeting opened up in prayer by Elva Lomayaktewa at 9:30 A.M.

Sign-in Sheet:

1. Elvis Cromwell – Requesting for additional land at his present site in Jurassic Park near the power line road. Board approved the request and for McDaniel to survey it.
2. Shane Burnette - Requesting for land site to build a skating park for the young people. He spoke to McDaniel on 3 different sites. 1. The area across from the service station, by the stop light. 2. By the old car wash, across from Bashes. 3. Near the food distribution area. They selected the site across from the stop lights here in town. Mr. Burnette showed the board brochures on the plan and let them know they are taken precautions. Board approved the request.
3. Sherrily Bonito – Requesting for land in Seven Mile, near the Apache Dawn homes. Board approved the request.
4. Gary Hill – Requesting for grazing land for horses. Mr. Hill was approved for land at the board meeting months back but found that the land is a archaeologist site, so he is back to request for a different area. The board suggested some areas that is available and ready to use for grazing and to meet with Environmental and I.H.S. On hold.
5. Lela Cosen – Their neighbor Troy Tortice is claiming all the land near their home in Seven Mile. Ms. Cosen explained to the members that the late Julius Colelay lived on that land for than 40 years and then had given it to Mr. Cosen so they assumed that it belonged to them and it is still all fenced in. Justin stated that they had already been approached on this land. The files show that Ms. Cosen's application is current and this particular land is on the application, but couldn't find anything on Mr. Tortice. Ms. Cosen will update her application and McDaniel will survey the lot for them.
6. Maxine Goklish – Requesting for land in Alchesay Flats for horse pasture, the lot is approximately 4 acres near Isaac Kasey's resident. Board approved the request and McDaniel is to survey the area.
7. Matthew Johnson – Requesting for additional land to the present one in Canyon Day. Board approved the application.
8. Victor Edwards Sr., - Requesting for land in East Fork, to use for a softball field. The area is being claim by others and need to be rechecked. Raymus will recheck on it and will let the board know. Also, requesting for additional land as his present site, this also needs to be rechecked, and McDaniel will check it out. On hold until further notice.

9. Abeita Cromwell - Requesting for land in Rainbow City near the EMT complex. Board approved the request.
10. Annette Zahgotah- Requesting for land in Rainbow City area, board approved the application.
11. Arlene Cosay – Requesting for land that belong to her late Grandfather Yale Cosay, brought paper from the courts. McDaniel told the board that the sketching on the application is wrong but will survey the area for Ms. Cosay. Board approved the request.
12. Asa Lavender – Requesting for additional land near his home in Hondah for horse pasture. He turned in the Livestock approval paper. Board approved the request.
13. Tyrone Gushoney – Requesting for the board to check into land assignment for his son Darrell Gushoney. The landsite was relinquished to Darrell by Simmons Altaha and he is claiming that Delbert Zahgotah Jr. is putting up post in this area. McDaniel stated that the area that Delbert is fencing in is his land assignment but Justin states that it belongs to Tyrone. Secretary asked for Darrell because it is in Darrell’s name. Tyrone will notify Darrell on this and will return at next month’s meeting.

14. Linda Truax – Requesting for additional land at her present location in Cradle board. Board denied request due to it being a right-of-way.
15. Floyd Dosela – Requesting for additional land to his present site to build a church. Board suggested that Cheryl Minjarez in Realty looks it over first. On hold.
16. Maria Naranjo - Relinquishing site in Hondah on Rim Road to Lydia Baha Alchesay. Board approved the request.
17. Erwin Caddo – Relinquishing site to Robinson Caddo, board approve the request.
18. Harold Truax – Requesting for land in Whiteriver, board approved the request.
19. Elton Thompson Sr., - Requesting for land in Canyon Day, board approved the request.

Raymus presented to the Board – Farmland Applications:

20. Marian Declay - Applying for farmland that was relinquished to her by her Grandmother Mary Patterson, board approved the request.
21. Robinson Caddo - Applying for farmland in Cibecue, which is being relinquish to him by Erwin Caddo. Board approved the request.
22. Orlando Carroll – Requesting for farm land in Hondah near his resident, in the Northfork district. Got approval from the livestock association. Board approved the request.
