



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Non-Member Hunting Regulations 2008-2009)


- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribe's Wildlife & Outdoor Recreation Division, (W&ORD), did this day come before the Tribal Council to request approval of the Non-Member Hunting Regulations for 2008-2009, as attached and incorporated by this reference; and
- WHEREAS,** W&ORD staff advised the Tribal Council that the hunting seasons, bag limits and regulations are based on sound biological principles, surveys and methods; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has reviewed the recommended Regulations and concurs that these will provide sustainable management of Tribal wildlife resources; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that the Non-Member Hunting Regulations for 2008-2009 are in the best interests of maintaining the natural resources within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Non-Member Hunting Regulations for 2008-2009, as attached and incorporated by this reference, are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on July 23, 2008, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
