

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Directing Housing Authority to review Theodora Lee housing)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed by Theodora Lee that she has been living in one of the China Town rental units for the last eighteen years; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Lee claims that she was advised by Housing Authority that a home will be built for her (information related to this may be noted in Housing Board minutes of July 1991); and

WHEREAS, Ms. Lee is concerned that she still lacks a home when she was promised one and she still wants a home.

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concedes that Housing Authority shall review Ms. Lee's concerns.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Housing Authority to fully review Ms. Lee's claims and concerns related to her home situation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 4, 2009</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
