

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving reimbursement to Council Member Victoria Brewer)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,

inter alia, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that

concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, members of the Tribal Council has historically supported one another during their time of

sorrow and loss; and

WHEREAS, the support includes financial assistance with burial expenses and beef donation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed that when Council Member Victoria Brewer's brother passed

last year, she was overlooked for assistance; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Victoria Brewer paid \$900.00 from her personal funds towards her brother's

funeral expense (see attached receipt); and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council apologizes for this oversight and concurs that Ms. Brewers should be

reimbursed \$900.00 which she personally incurred.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a reimbursement of \$900.00 to Council Member Victoria Brewer for expenses she personally incurred as described above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 27, 2009, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
