

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving \$1,000 to Reagan Armstrong for his son's graduation from the Wildland Firefighter training in Sycuan Indian Reservation)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Chief Judge Reagan Armstrong's son, Reagan Henry Armstrong, Jr., has successfully completed his advanced firefighter training and will be graduating from Wildland Firefighter training at the Sycuan Indian Reservation on April 25, 2009; and

WHEREAS, this achievement is held in high regard by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Tribe to approve \$1,000 to assist the Armstrong family with Reagan Henry Armstrong, Jr.'s graduation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and authorizes \$1,000 to be paid immediately to Chief Judge Reagan Armstrong for his son's graduation at the Sycuan Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event of any conflict between this Resolution and any other Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 23, 2009, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
