

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Emergency financial assistance for Dorothea Ivins)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Tribal member Dorothea Ivins has come before the Tribal Council this day to report that her sister, Nancy Beach, was involved in a serious accident which requires surgery at a Phoenix hospital; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Ivins requests financial assistance so that she and her family members may travel to Phoenix to be with her sister; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves assistance in the amount of \$250.00 to Dorothea Ivins for the purposes stated above.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves an emergency financial assistance of \$250.00 to Dorothea Ivins.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 2009, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
