

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Financial Assistance for Travel to Wake and Funeral)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed that tribal member Pam Lupe's son recently passed away and Ms. Lupe and her daughter, Kimari, are currently out of the State; and

WHEREAS, the family requests financial assistance in the amount of four hundred and thirty dollars (\$430.00) to purchase two airline tickets for Pam and Kimari Lupe so they may return to Whiteriver, AZ for the wake and funeral of their son and brother; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, by consensus, agrees to provide aid to the Lupe family so that they may travel back to Whiteriver, AZ for the wake and funeral of their family member.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves financial assistance in the amount of four hundred and thirty dollars (\$430.00) for airline tickets so that the Lupe family may return to Whiteriver for the wake and funeral of their family member.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event of any inconsistency between this Resolution and any prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 15, 2009</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (k), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
