

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing Ivan Kitcheyan to Hire Temporary Consultant Alison Zajacek)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that the Grants and Contracts department, currently managed by Ivan Kitcheyan, requires additional support to ensure that federal funding is properly secured and managed to remain in good standing with the federal government; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is also aware that an audit of 2007, 2008 and 2009 tribal accounting is currently underway and in order to ensure that the Tribe's record keeping is accurate and in compliance with federal guidelines, Ivan Kitcheyan is requesting the hiring of an expert consultant to assist with the accounting; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council previously recognized the importance of the audits in process, and as per Resolution 06-2009-201, authorized Tribal Treasurer Cathy Tate to hire a consultant for record keeping and federal compliance purposes; and
- WHEREAS, due to the unique circumstances that require urgent and timely assistance with the Tribe's records, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to allow Ivan Kitcheyan to hire Alison Zajacek of Resources Global Professionals; and
- WHEREAS, given the urgency of the Tribe's record keeping needs and to prevent the Tribe from falling into high risk status with the federal government, the Tribal Council further finds that hiring an accountant will strongly benefit the Grants and Contracts Department and the Tribe and may prevent non-compliance concerns and should be considered and made outside of a regularly scheduled meeting; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that: (1) this Resolution may be voted upon by signature of a member of the Tribal Council where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (2) the Tribal Council Secretary should attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (3) no signature would mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (4) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes Ivan Kitcheyan to hire Alison Zajacek of Resources Global Professionals, pending legal review, to assist with accounting and ensure the Tribe is compliant with Federal Law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that given the urgency of the request described herein, this Resolution may be voted upon as follows: (a) by signature of a member of the Tribal Council, including the Chairman of the Tribal

Council and the Vice-Chairwoman of the Tribal Council, where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (b) the Tribal Council Secretary shall attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (c) no signature shall mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (d) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature, and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 6, 2009</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (c), (i), (s) (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
