

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Directing BIA to Complete Tonto Timber Sale)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache

Tribe intervalia, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Triba and act in all matters that

concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, on this day, Charles E. Peone, Jr., Acting General Manager of the Fort Apache Timber Company

(FATCO), did present a "Turnaround" budget to the Tribal Council, highlighting the need for ponderosa pine from the Tonto Timber Sale that cannot be provided in the Lofer Timber Sale and

that such approval be obtained no later than October; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been asked to consider directing the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) to

approve of the Tonto Timber Sale as soon as possible due to seasonal and financial considerations in

support of the Turnaround Operating Plan accepted in the FATCO Budget; and

WHEREAS, the BIA has previously advised the Tribal Council that the Tonto Timber Sale would be scheduled

for approval earlier in the year but has yet to present the relevant information to the Tribal Council

and therefore formalizing timber sale approvals via resolution; and

WHEREAS, as of mid-August, the Tonto Timber Sale has not been presented to the Tribal Council and the

Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Tribe to expedite the timber sale in order to meet

the Tribe's immediate economic needs; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that the BIA should abide by its work schedule and immediately

complete any remaining timber pre-sale work to approve of the Tonto Timber Sale and allow the Tribe to complete the transaction immediately or in any case, report to the Tribal Council on the status of the Tonto Timber Sale, including recommendations on expediting the remainder of the work

required to obtain final approval.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the BIA to expedite the process and approval of the Tonto Timber Sale in order to protect the economic interests of the Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 14, 2009</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (c), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act/of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
