

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing IGA between Whiteriver Unified School District #20 and the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain

Apache Tribe, inter alia, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and

act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe encourages the advancement of educational

opportunities and general knowledge of all residents of the Fort Apache Indian

Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe and Whiteriver Unified School District #20 have agreed in principle to share

expenses and responsibilities related to an additional classroom to be used by the Head

Start Program; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Tribe to enter into an

Intergovernmental Agreement with the Whiteriver Unified School District #20 to

establish the responsibilities of all related parties in the administration of the additional

Head Start classroom; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that this decision should be made outside of its regularly

scheduled meeting due to the deadline and to prevent further delay of the administration

of this accord; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that: (1) this Resolution may be voted upon by

signature of a member of the Tribal Council where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (2) the Tribal Council Secretary should attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (3) no signature would mean that the respective Tribal Council members is against this Resolution, (4) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the

respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby agrees to enter into an IGA with the Whiteriver Unified School District #20 for the purpose of administering an additional Head Start classroom for the benefit of Tribal Members on the Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that due to the timing of this contract and associated deadlines, this decision shall be made outside of the Council's regularly scheduled meeting to prevent further delay of services to eligible Tribal members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe finds that: (1) this Resolution may be voted upon by signature of a member of the Tribal Council where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (2) the Tribal Council Secretary should attempt to

obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (3) no signature would mean that the respective Tribal Council members is against this Resolution, (4) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **NOVEMBER 25, 2009** duly adopted by a vote of **SIX** for and **ZERO** against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
