

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing Youth Crusade at Chief Alchesay Activity Center)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Member Veldon Clendon and spouse Debra of the Hope Center came before the Tribal Council to provide information related to the proposed Youth Crusade; and

WHEREAS, the Warriors Arise Youth Crusade is scheduled to take place between March 18th and 20th of 2010 in the Chief Alchesay Activity Center, in Whiteriver, AZ; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to support the Youth Crusade for the purpose of benefitting Apache tribal youth.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Youth Crusade to be held on March 18-20, 2010 and hosted at the Chief Alchesay Activity Center in Whiteriver, AZ.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event of any inconsistency between this Resolution and any prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 14, 2010</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (g), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
