

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approval to Hire Elva Lomayaktewa as Secretary to the Director of the Tribal Land Office)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Land Office ("Tribal Land Office") is responsible for coordinating the Tribe's land policies and for the administration of land within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, one of the primary duties of the Tribal Land Office is to process Tribal members' requests for land to be used for home sites, businesses or agriculture; and
- WHEREAS, Raymus Albert, the Tribal Land Office Director, indicated his office received numerous applications for land and that the work-load requires that he have a Secretary; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Albert indicated Elva Lomayaktewa previously held the position of Secretary to the Director of the Tribal Land Office and was of great assistance to him, he recommended that she be reinstated to that position; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the Tribal Land Office provides a critical function and that Mr. Albert's request for Ms. Elva Lomayaktewa to be hired to her previous position as Secretary should be granted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby hires Elva Lomayaktewa to her former position as Secretary to the Director of the Tribal Land Office effective immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents as necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>OCTOBER 14, 2010</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
